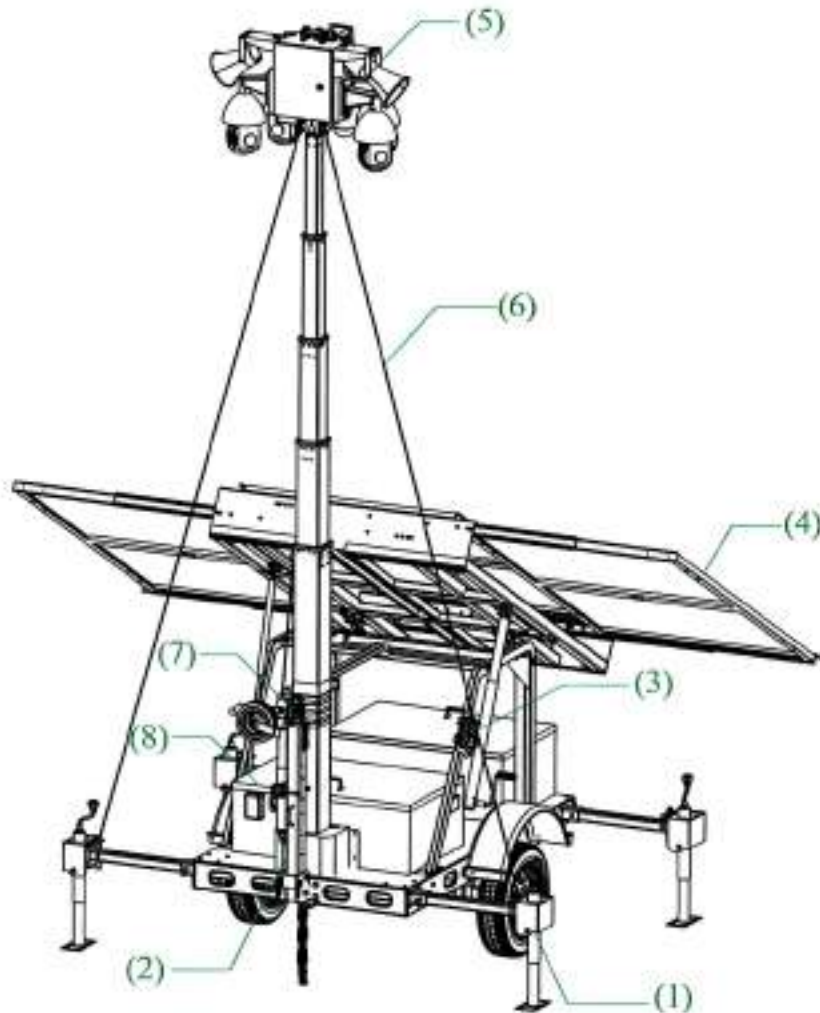
About the LumiGuardian

The LumiGuardian deters crime with flashing lights, deterrent floodlights, real-time alerts, and audio warnings.

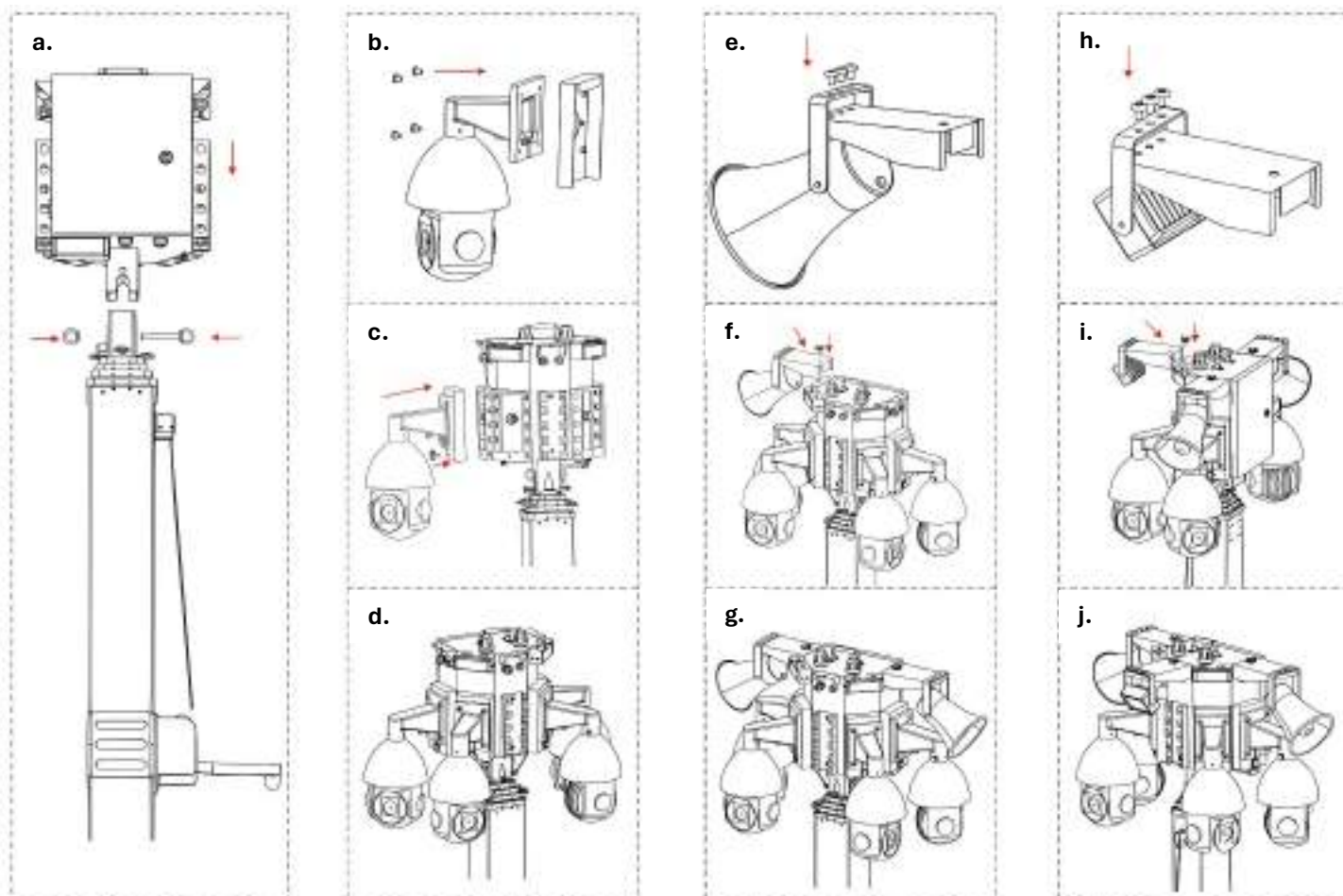
How to Set Up the LumiGuardian for Use

Follow the steps below to set up the LumiGuardian for use. The steps correspond to area numbered on the diagram.

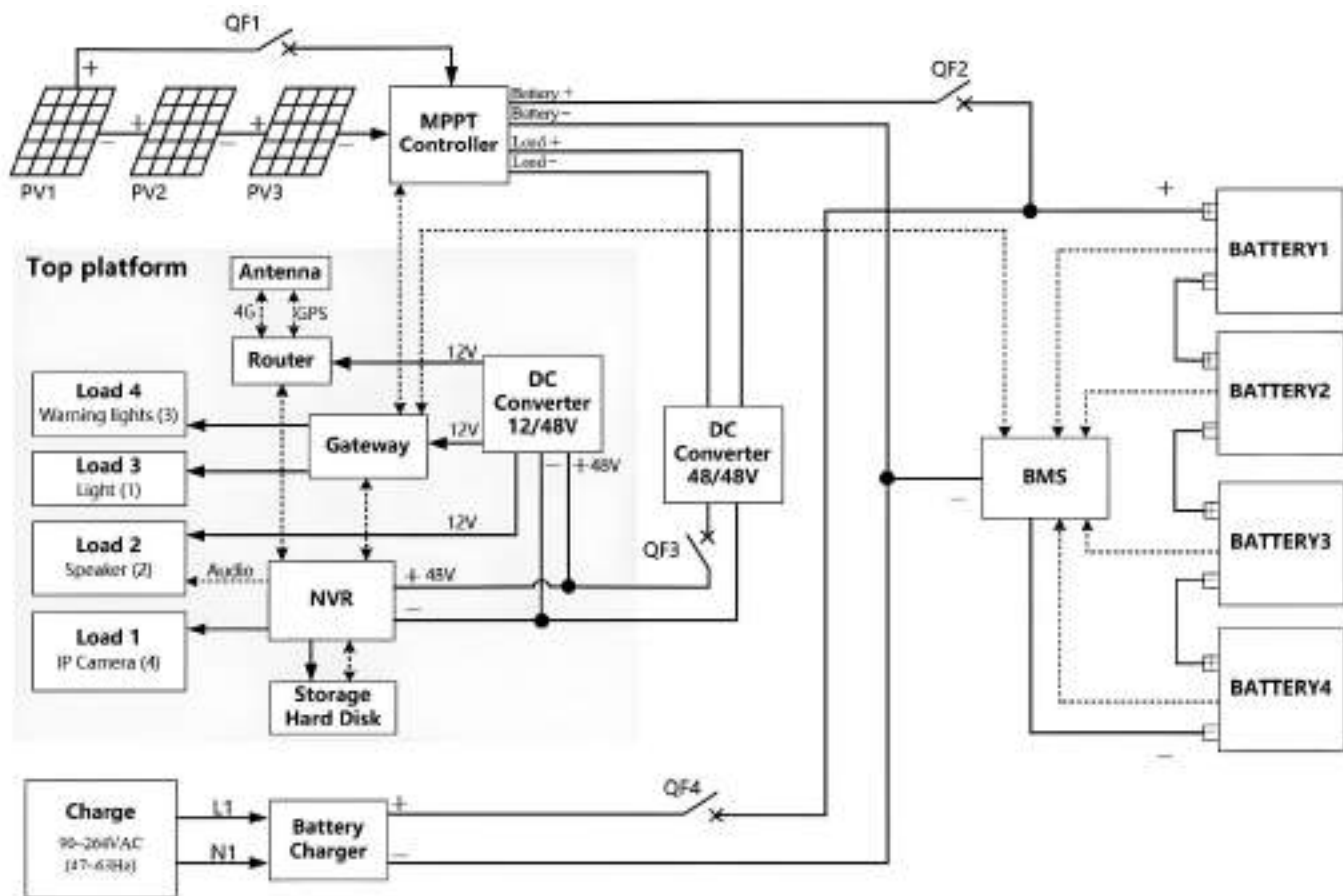
① Some of the instructions may vary based on the version of the trailer.



1. Pull the four corner supports outward to fully extend them.
2. Fold in the tow arm.
3. Turn the hand crank to adjust the angle of the solar panel. The panel should be positioned at an angle that allows maximum sunlight exposure.
4. Pull on the sides of the solar panel to fully extend it.
5. Follow the diagram below to install the control box and attach the cameras and speakers.



- a. Install the control box by pushing the box on top of the mast and securing with the o-ring bolt and nut.
 - b. Attach the camera and mounting bracket to the mounting plate with hex screws.
 - c. Install the camera onto the control box using the black knob screw.
 - d. Repeat steps (b) and (c) for all cameras.
 - e. Attach the speaker to the arm using hex screws.
 - f. Install the speaker onto the control box using the black knob screw.
 - g. Repeat steps (e) and (f) on the other side of the control box.
 - h. Mount the floodlight to the arm using hex screws.
 - ① The floodlight may ship pre-mounted. If so, skip this step.
 - i. Install the floodlight onto the control box using the black knob screw.
 - j. Repeat steps (h) and (i) on the other side.
6. Attach the steel cables using the carabiners. One end of the cable will attach to the corner support, while the other end will attach to the bottom of the control box. Repeat on each side of the trailer.
 7. Extend the mast of the trailer using the silver hand crank with the red handle. Stop when the red line appears.
 8. Open the electrical box using the small silver key from the storage box. Power on the trailer computer to verify the trailer computer is functioning properly. The diagram below shows the inside layout of the electrical box.

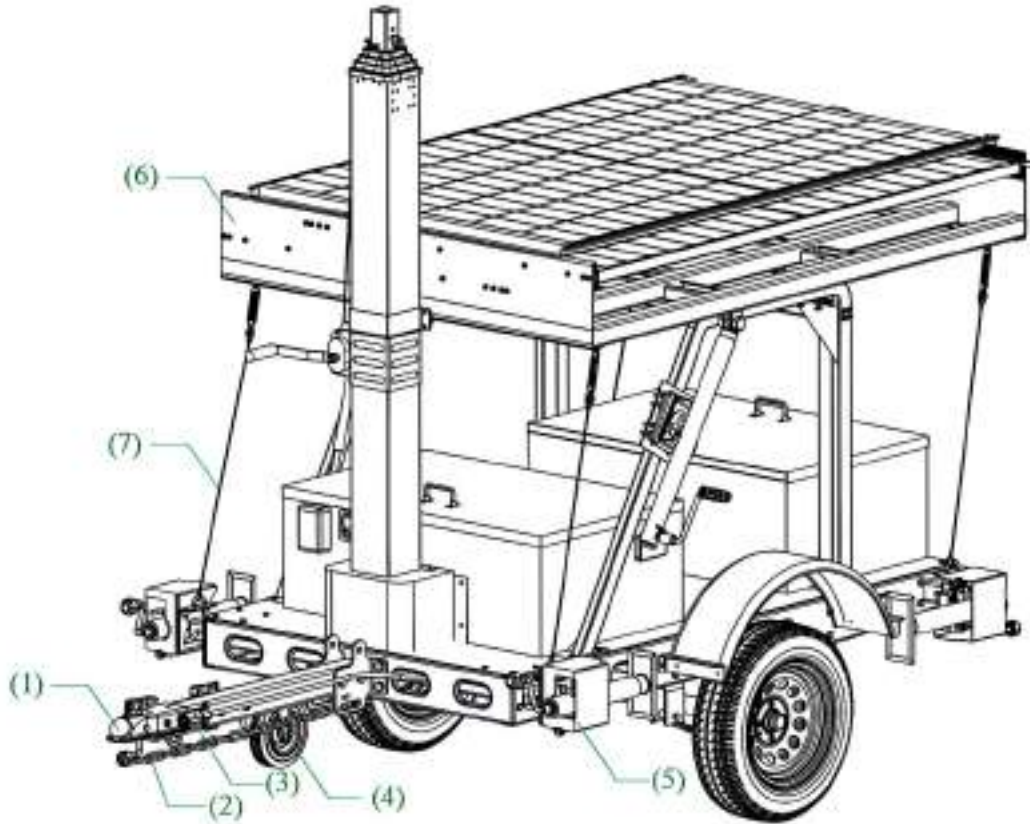


The trailer is now set up and ready to use.

How to Prepare the LumiGuardian for Transport

Follow the steps below to prepare the LumiGuardian trailer for transport. The steps correspond to area numbered on the diagram.

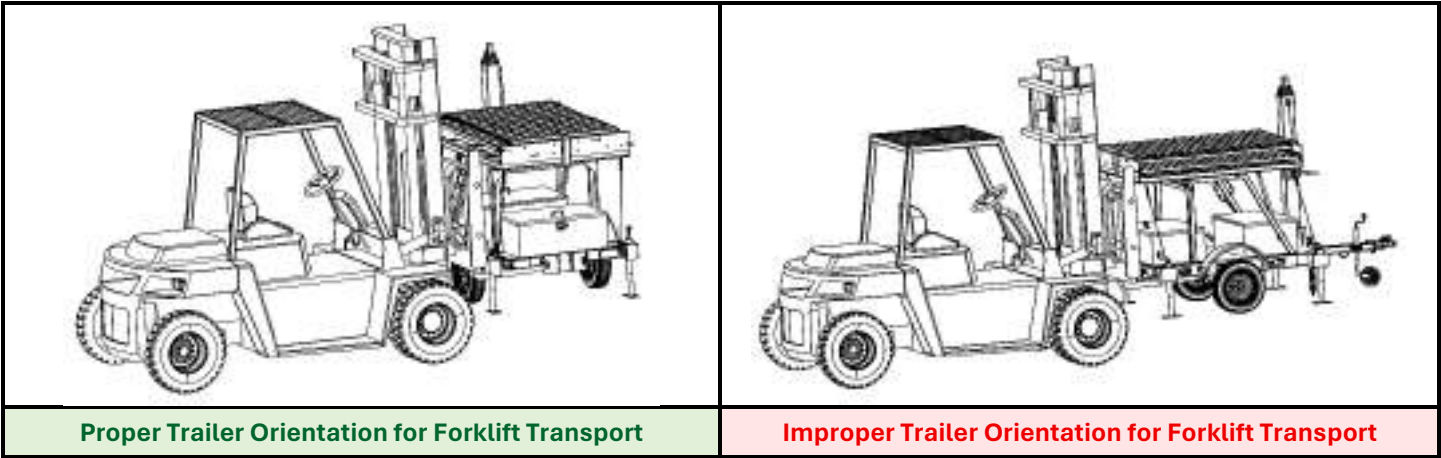
① Some of the instructions may vary based on the version of the trailer.



1. Pull out the trailer's tow arm and securely attach the ball connector.
2. Reattach the iron chain to the front connector.
3. Connect the signal line plug from the trailer to the transport vehicle or tractor.
4. Retract the leading wheel to reduce drag while transporting.
5. Pull in the four corner supports. Ensure the supports are evenly retracted to ensure proper balance.
6. Use the hand crank to retract the solar panel.
7. Use four steel wire ropes and carabiners to secure the solar panel to the four corner supports.

Forklift Transport Guidelines

Only lift the trailer from both sides or the front when using a forklift. This ensures maximum visibility and control. **Do not** lift from the rear of the trailer.
